

ACTIVITY OF THE YEAR

The Activity of the Year contest recognizes up to 6 outstanding Chapter Activities—3 short term and 3 long term. The applications must be submitted by May 1 of each year. The rubrics being used at the present time are the following.

The points range from:

5-1 (Superior—5 pts; Excellent—4 pts; Good—3 points; Fair—2 pts; Okay—1 pt.)

Three major areas are being considered—service to community, use of Spanish language and appreciation of Hispanic culture.

Superior (5 pts.)

Service to community to include global as well as local
Major use of Spanish language
Demonstrates a great deal of appreciation of Hispanic culture

Excellent (4 pts.)

Service to community mainly local
Considerable use of Spanish language
Demonstrates much appreciation of Hispanic culture

Good (3 pts.)

Service to community, mainly on campus only
Some use of Spanish language
Shows some appreciation of Hispanic culture

Fair (2 pts.)

Limited service to community
Little use of Spanish language
Very little demonstration of appreciation of Hispanic culture

Okay (1 pt.)

Service is limited to small and not very needy segment of the community
Use of Spanish language is not required to perform activity
Appreciation of Hispanic culture is not demonstrated

After the selections are made, contact the ND's office before making any announcements to check the teacher's AATSP membership status and the active status of the Chapter. When the approval is given, send letters of congratulation and a certificate to each of the chapters that has won and letters to those who have not won, thanking them for their participation and encouraging them to apply again in the future.
