

## STATE DIRECTOR OF THE YEAR

A) Evidence of presentation(s) about SHH to Spanish Teachers at local, state or regional meetings.

B)

2 points: evidence of a presentation to a group.

1 point: little evidence of presentation to a group.

0 point: no evidence of presentation to a group.

B) Evidence of creative efforts to promote SHH via communication with teachers [website, invitations, congratulation cards, etc].

2 points: evidence of creative promotion.

1 point: little evidence of creative promotion.

0 point: no evidence of creative promotion.

C) Evidence of individual contacts with Spanish teachers about the SHH via letters, telephone calls or e-mails.

3 points: evidence of telephone calls made, and many letters and e-mails sent.

2 points: evidence of some calls made, and some letters and e-mails sent.

1 point: little evidence -one letter sent, one call made.

0 point: no evidence of creative communication to promote SHH.

In the event of a tie in points, the President of SHH and the National Directors will make the final decision.

NOTE: State Directors must submit evidence of presentations made at conferences about SHH, in the form of copies of the program session. They also must submit examples of creative efforts, such as copies of letters and e-mails sent to provide documentation of efforts. State Directors are judged on the efforts they make to promote and develop the SHH in their state. State Directors are not judged on their classroom abilities or their abilities to promote their own SHH chapters. Presentations made at conferences must focus directly on the SHH and not on other topics.
